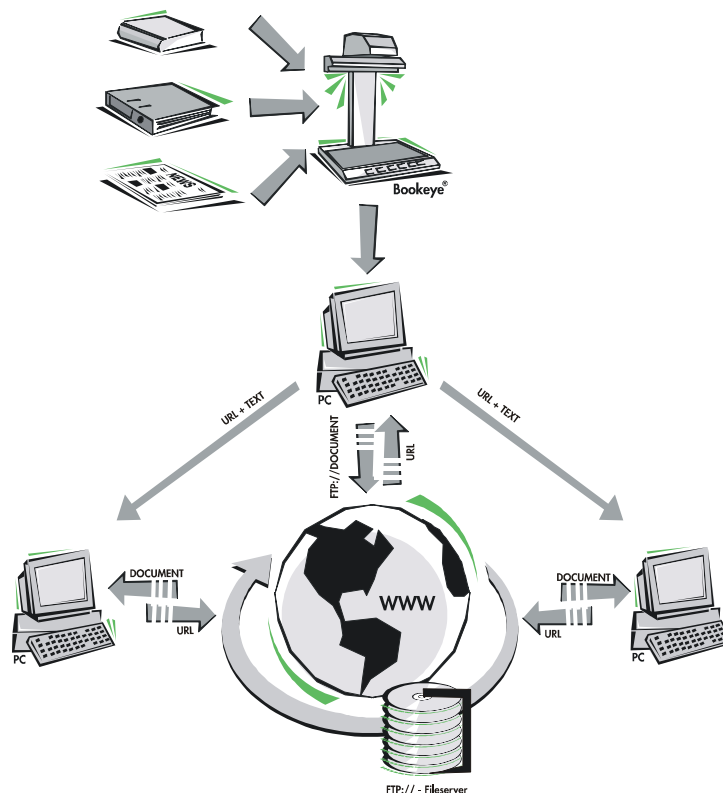
### BCS-2 FTP-Module

#### What's FTP?

FTP means File Transfer Protocol and is the international standard for copying files on the Internet. FTP can be used with all standard browsers. Most FTP servers have a guest access for public use (anonymous FTP). The access can be restricted to selected users with a user name and password.

#### Product Description

The FTP-Module of BCS-2 provides fast and cost-effective delivery of scanned documents. The documents are transferred and saved to an FTP-Server directly from the BCS-2 software. The customer automatically receives a message that his order is ready, and he can decide for himself when he wants to download it to his local system.



## Features

- FTP binary transport is faster than e-mail protocol
- Minimizes transfer time and network load
- Minimizes transport and routing costs for dial-in connections
- Avoids rejected mails caused by overflow of size-limited mailboxes
- Access to documents is independent of location and time
- Single transfer of a document for delivery to more than one customer

## Applications

- Document delivery for articles from books and periodicals (JASON, Medea-3, Subito, MyBib)
- Central scanning of inboxes, especially for companies with remote locations
- Publishing of documents on the Internet
- Scanning on demand especially for remote archives and registries

## Functions

The FTP function is available as an additional option in the "scan-order" window.

The scanned document is transferred in binary mode to a freely definable FTP server. At the same time a definable e-mail message is generated and sent to the user by MAPI or SMTP.

The message contains a hyperlink that can be used to download the documents to the customer's local system at any time. The FTP access by the BCS-2 Software can be configured as an anonymous FTP or as a password protected FTP.

- BCS-2-MAPI recommended

## Installation, Delivery

The FTP option is delivered via e-mail and plug-in integrated in BCS-2.
